## A Message from the Park Hills Police Department

Talking about snow when leaves are falling seems premature, but snow flakes will be falling before you know it. We always like to put an article in the HUB so our residents know what to do with their vehicles when a snow emergency is declared.

First of all, a snow emergency is declared when it is determined that falling snow, sleet or freezing rain requires restricting of vehicular traffic for the purpose of plowing or cleaning snow and ice.

There will be no parking on city streets when snow exceeds three inches or during declared snow emergency.

A vehicle parked on the pavement or right of way of any dedicated street at the time of the snow emergency is declared will be removed within three hours if the snow emergency is declared between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. If declared between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., the vehicle will be removed prior to 9:00 a.m. of that morning.

Please be cooperative and considerate. If it is snowing hard in the morning and they are predicting an accumulation of snow, park any vehicles that you own on your driveway. We don't like to tow vehicles, but it may be necessary in order to get the streets cleaned and to avoid accidents. Denis Finke does a great job. Make it a little easier on him!

Officer Shepherd has been a police officer since 1995. He has served on the City of Ft. Wright Police Department and also the Lakeside Park-Crestview Hills Police Authority. He received his 400 hours of basic training through the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training in Richmond, Kentucky and he has taken a number of yearly in-service training classes.

Officer Joe Gonzalez was an officer with the Xavier University Campus Police. Since March of 1997, he was working for the Lincoln Heights, Ohio Police Department.

Officer John Eddy also comes from the Lincoln Heights Police Department, serving with them since 1996.

Both Officer Gonzalez and Officer Eddy received over 400 hours of basic training through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy in Cincinnati and they have completed the necessary classes through the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training to certify them in the State of Kentucky.

We hope you will welcome Officers John Eddy, Joe Gonzalez and Joel Shepherd to the City of Park Hills.
