# LARGE ITEM PICK-UP DAY, MONDAY, MAY 16 TH

Each year, The City of Park Hills sets aside a day in May for our waste hauler to pick-up large items. This year, Rumpke will be making pick-ups on Monday morning, May 16th, following the city-wide yard sale. Rumpke will take most anything but there are a few exceptions and restrictions:

1. Any items with Freon (air conditioners or refrigerators) must have a tag indicating the Freon has been removed. An AC or Refrigerator Company that removes the Freon will provide the tag, or you can attach the one from this page. The item will not be picked up by Rumpke without the tag.

**Note: Items containing Freon can be dropped off at the Kenton County Public Works located at 420 Independence Station Road, Independence, KY. If you have any questions, you may call them at 392-1920.**

2. Yard waste, such as leaves, must be in bags or cans. Branches and twigs must be tied together in lengths of no more than five feet. Bundles must be less than 40 lbs.
3. Rumpke will not pick up Hazardous Wastes such as paint thinners, oils, solvents, tires, batteries, etc.

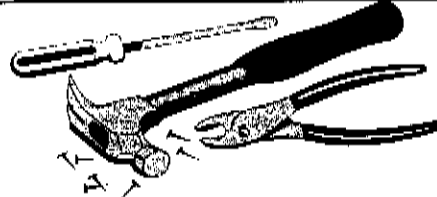

## 2005 "BEAUTIFICATION AWARDS"

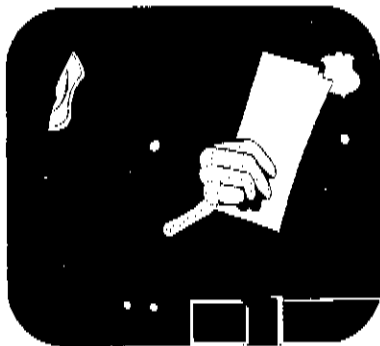
